This historic port town is an important Japanese cultural capital. From tea and Zen practices to arts and technology, most of the cultural aspects of Japan began in Osaka.

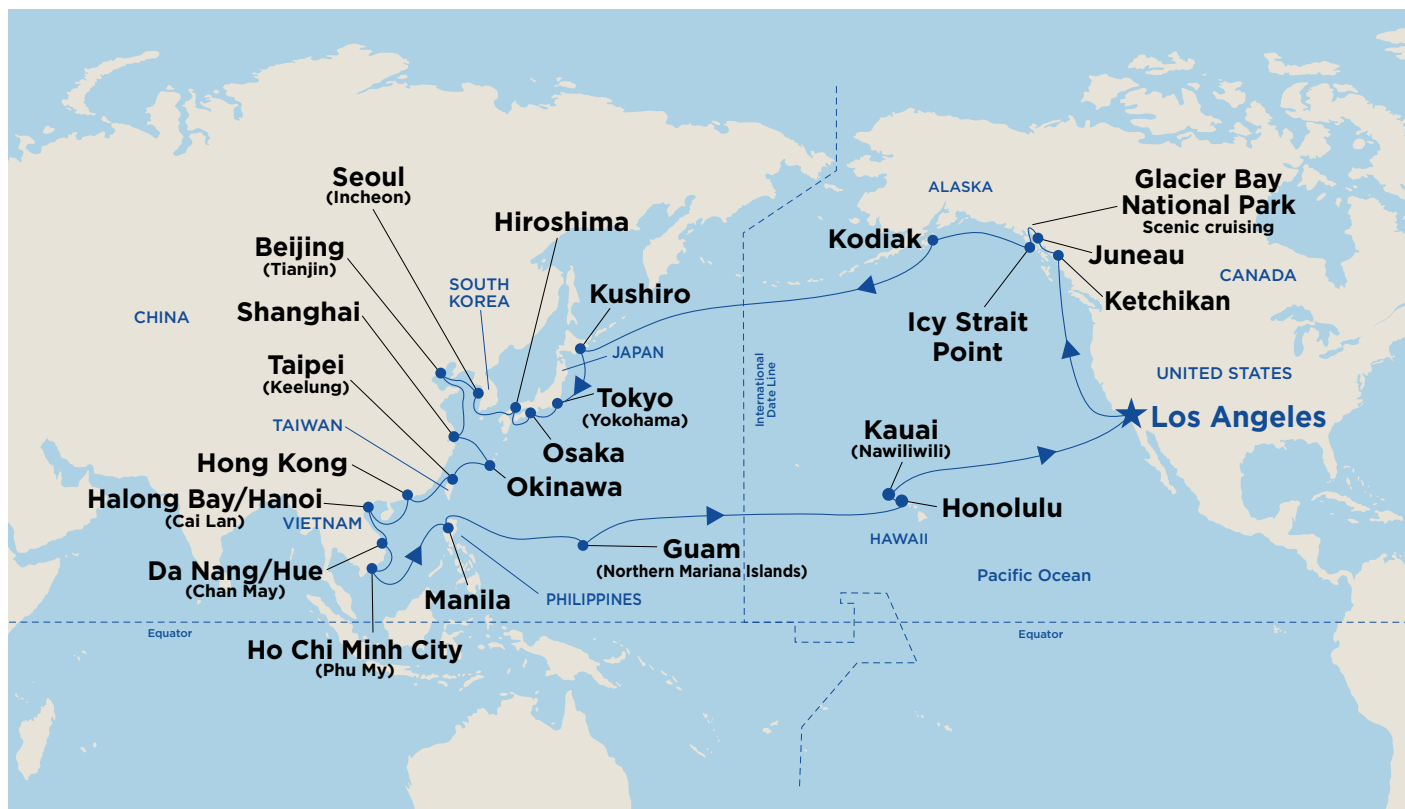
Taipei
